We explained that lots of people wear red poppies because these flowers grew after the war on the fields. ## **IMPORTANT**

Dear Parents. Becky and Paulette are working towards allocating your children to a key worker. The key worker to your child is a named practitioner who has responsibilities for a small group of children. They are there to help your child feel safe and secure. The role is important for both the child and their parents/carer and it is an approach set out in the EYFS. The key person will respond to the children's needs. Becky and Paulette will oversee all the children at Toras Chaim to ensure that they are developing well, that their needs are being met and that they are engaged in all 7 areas of learning according to the EYFS. Any questions then please do ask to speak to Becky or Paulette.

Please bring your child into nursery as prompt as possible so that they can start their nursery day. Please understand that we cannot accept any child into the nursery prior to their time stated on our, so if you are early then please note that we will not be able to take your child in. If you are running late collecting your child then please do give us a quick call so that we can arrange our staff cover if needed.

If a child is ill with a temperature then they will be excluded for 48 hrs. If they have vomiting or diarrhea they will be excluded for 48 hrs from their last bout. This is to protect the other children as well as staff and to minimise an outbreak within the nursery.

Please do remember to label all water bottles and lunch boxes. Thank you.

We will be introducing Rise & Shine every morning. These are fun little exercise to music to help the children understand how to keep their bodies fit and healthy and to allow them to express the different ways that their bodies can move.

Please remember that Show & Tell will now be on Wednesdays.
