In this week's parsha of Bamidbor, we learn about the 12 Mattos (Tribes) of the Bnei Yisroel. Each Tribe had their very own flag with a special sign on it. Each Tribe had a leader! We learnt the names of the 12 Tribes through singing:

Reuben, Shimon, Levi, Yehudah, Yissachar, Zevulun, Dan, Naftoli, Gad, Asher, Yosef and Binyomin!

We also learn how the B'nei Yisroel had to walk through the desert carrying the Mishkan! Imagine carrying something so heavy through a desert! OI VEY!

Monday: Let's start our week!.....
